



WHAT'S A ROUNDABOUT?

A roundabout is a one-way circular intersection engineered to maximize safety, reduce traffic congestion and moderate traffic flow.

To safely and efficiently navigate a roundabout:

1

Slow down. Look left, right, left. Yield to traffic in roundabout, including pedestrians and bicyclists.

2

Enter the circle by bearing right. **Cycle in the center of the lane.** If you are a pedestrian, cross only at a designated crosswalk.

3

Signal right before exiting the roundabout. Watch for pedestrians crossing your path.



Vehicles should travel single file through a roundabout, including bicycles.

Treat a traffic circle with stop signs like a regular intersection with stop signs: look left, right, left, then go when it's your turn and safe.
