Annual Review of Municipal Fees

The City charges fees for a variety of services provided, such as fees for room rentals, building inspection services, and photocopies. As part of the annual budget process, the City's Municipal Fee Schedule is reviewed to ensure that fees are set in accordance with applicable federal and state laws, in addition to the City of Palo Alto User Fee Cost Recovery Level Policy. City departments review their fees for services and make recommendations to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) to add new fees, delete existing fees, and make changes to existing fees. In coordination with departments, OMB reviews amendments to the Municipal Fee Schedule to ensure that fees are consistent with applicable policies and procedures. As part of best practices and to support continued alignment with cost recovery goals, OMB also reviews fees annually to reflect changes in service levels, operating costs, and policy direction, as appropriate. Proposed amendments to the Municipal Fee Schedule are submitted to the Finance Committee for review and discussion during the annual budget process, prior to being recommended for adoption by the City Council. The Fiscal Year 2027 Municipal Fee Schedule was adopted by the City Council on June 15, 2026.

Cost Recovery

Some fees are subject to limits under Proposition 26, which requires that the amount of the fee must be “no more than necessary to recover the reasonable costs of the government activity, and that the manner in which those costs are allocated to a payor bear a fair or reasonable relationship to the payor’s burden on, or benefits received from, the governmental activity. California Constitution, Article XIII C, Sec. 1(e). Other types of fees, such as fines, penalties and/or late charges, or charges imposed for entrance to or use of, as well as the purchase, rental, or lease of local government property, are expressly exempted from the provision quoted above and not required to be based on actual costs of providing service. Instead, policymakers may consider local market rates, reasonableness, and other policy factors in setting fee levels. Fees such as facility rental fees or golf course greens fees fall into this category.

Understanding the Municipal Fee Schedule

The Municipal Fee Schedule provides a detailed listing of fees by department. Fees that are not specific to a particular department are found in the Citywide section. Within each department, fees are broadly divided by service area or division. In each section table, fees are further grouped by activity or service in alphabetical order. Each fee is listed along with the City Council adopted rate for the current fiscal year. Where applicable, multiple fee tiers are shown to reflect factors such as residency, non-profit status, or regular and overtime service rates. The Municipal Fee Schedule does not include commodity rates for Electric, Fiber, Gas, Refuse, Stormwater, Water, and Wastewater Collection services. CLASSIFICATION AND USE OF FEES

Class I - City Use and City-Sponsored Activities: No charge for facility rental for events or activities, however, fees for attendants, equipment rental, and special uses may apply. (Note: City facility use for City co-sponsored groups will be considered on a case by case basis.)

Class II - 501(c)3 Non-Profit Organizations: IRS recognized non-profit 501(c)3 organizations may receive a 50% reduction on basic facility rental rates upon verification. Only facility rental rates may be reduced and all other fees, such as staffing and equipment, are charged at the full rate. Non-profit organizations charging or collecting fees or raising funds are not eligible for reduced rates and basic fees will apply. This does not apply to class registration fees.

Class III - Individuals, Groups, Organizations, and Businesses not charging fees: Basic rental fees apply.

Class IV - Business or Commercial Use: Individuals, groups, organizations, and businesses charging, collecting, or raising funds may rent facilities and equipment at the basic rate plus 75%. The Art Center is not available for CLASS IV.

Payment, Scheduling, and Service Installation Requirements

The customer must pay all applicable plan review, connection, and related fees in full prior to scheduling any Utility construction work or inspections. Invoices will be issued to the responsible party identified on the Service Application and are valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance. Once CPAU has received full payment, verified that all applicable service requirements have been satisfied, and the Utilities Inspector has determined that the project is ready for utility installation, CPAU staff will schedule the project for construction.

Service installation timelines vary depending on the type of service requested, material availability, and scheduling constraints. In general, CPAU can provide service availability within 30 to 45 days after all required fees have been paid; however, installation may take between 60 and 90 days for projects requiring Utility construction work. Longer lead times may be necessary when specialized or long lead-time equipment and materials, such as transformers, switches, or cable, are required. Customers should consult CPAU for current scheduling and lead-time estimates.

While CPAU makes every reasonable effort to complete installations as scheduled, delays may occur due to unforeseen conditions or circumstances beyond CPAU's control, including material procurement delays. Regular CPAU work hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding City holidays. Any work that the City determines must be performed outside of regular work hours will be charged at the applicable overtime rate as provided in the Miscellaneous Fees section. Such circumstances may include, but are not limited to, work performed on arterial streets, within business districts, in front of major commercial establishments, or near schools.

Electric connection fees apply to all connections, interconnections, expansions, and upgrades to the City's Electric Distribution System, except for services related to street lighting or traffic signals within CPAU's electric service territory. These fees also apply to vacant land unless documentation exists demonstrating that the applicable fees have previously been paid. Rebates or credits may be available to offset electric service connection charges when a service upgrade is necessitated by increased electrical demand resulting from electric vehicle charging.

For additional information regarding utility service requirements and regulations, please refer to the City's Utility Rules and Regulations at: City of Palo Alto Utility Rules and Regulations, including Rule and Regulation 20 (Special Electric Regulations), Rule and Regulation 21 (Special Water Regulations), Rule and Regulation 22 (Special Gas Regulations), and Rule and Regulation 23 (Special Wastewater Regulations).

All fees and minimum charges are subject to California Construction Cost Index (CCCI) adjustments, to be applied annually effective on July 1.
