Sundays and Holidays*	Construction Prohibited

CITY HOLIDAYS*

New Year's Day – January 1st	Labor Day – The first Monday in September
Martin Luther King Day – The third Monday in January	People's Indigenous Day – The second Monday in October
Washington's Birthday – The third Monday in February	Veteran's Day – November 11th
Memorial Day – The last Monday in May	Thanksgiving Day – The fourth Thursday in November
Independence Day – July 4th	Christmas Day – December 25th

NOISE

- ☐ The contractor shall ensure that noise meets the following requirements (PAMC 9.10.060):
 - No individual piece of equipment shall exceed 110 DbA, measured 25' from such equipment.
 - Noise level at any point outside of the construction property plane shall not exceed 110DbA.
 - The use of amplified music or other sound in the work area is not permitted during the performance of the work.

SIGN

- ☐ The construction hours sign(s) shall be posted 5' above ground level and shall be visible to the street at all entrances to the construction site. (PAMC 9.10.060)
 - See "Address and Premises Identification" inspection checklist for address requirements during temporary construction.

VIOLATION AND POLICE DEPARTMENT INVOLVEMENT

- ☐ Violation of these restrictions is a misdemeanor punishable by a maximum of six months in jail, a \$1,000 fine, or both. Violators will be prosecuted or given an administrative citation. (PAMC 9.10.060)
