




Churchill Avenue Enhanced Bikeway Project Neighborhood Construction Briefing May 1, 2025

Churchill Avenue Project Area





Project Background

March 2014

City awarded contract to Sandis Engineering for Design of the Project

January 2015

Council approved the Concept plan for the Project

October 2015

Community Workshop

Summer 2018

Project was placed on hold due to staffing shortages in the Office of Transportation

November 2019

- City restarted project
 - Obtained Permits from Caltrans
 - Obtained Right-of-Way easements
 - Worked on utility relocation plans
 - Developed construction documents
 - Procure Contractor



Proposed Improvements

Improvements on Churchill Avenue:

- Extend existing bicycle path from Castilleja to the Stanford Perimeter Trail
- High visibility crosswalks at Castilleja
- New lighting and curb improvements at Castilleja
- New High Visibility Crosswalk and Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon at Madrono
- Restriping and repaving on Churchill
- Landscaping/tree planting along school frontage

Intersection safety improvements at El Camino Real:

- Remove pork chop island Add a right turn only storage lane on westbound
 Churchill to northbound El Camino Real
- Enhanced bicycle and pedestrian crosswalks at all 3 crossings of intersection and improved signalized intersection




Churchill Avenue/El Camino Real – Existing Conditions





Churchill Avenue – Project Layout


El Camino Real to PAUSD Driveway

- Contractor on the project: O'Grady Construction
- Order all Electrical and Signal Equipment: Spring 2025
- Construction Begin: Summer 2025
 - Underground utility work
 - Concrete work
 - El Camino Intersection
 - Irrigation and Planting
 - Paving and striping
- Construction End: Summer 2026


