 2 A tree that falls within the category of a Protected Tree includes Street Trees, Designated Landscape Plan Trees, Heritage Trees, Protected Native Species Trees and all trees over 15" in diameter at 54-inches above natural grade that are located within private or public property and which must be maintained in accordance with the standards and regulations contained in the Tree and Landscape Technical Manual.
 3 The area within X distance from the trunk of a tree, measured from the perimeter of the trunk of the tree at 54-inches above natural grade, where X equals a distance ten times the diameter of the trunk at 54-inches above natural grade.
