Pearson-Arastradero Nature Preserve, Palo Alto Project Timeline: April 1, 2025 – June 30, 2025

Project Overview

The City of Palo Alto is initiating a comprehensive upgrade of trail signage throughout the **Pearson-Arastradero Nature Preserve** to improve trail navigation, visitor safety, and access to natural and educational resources.

Scope of Work

- **Wayfinding Signs:** Replacement of directional trail markers to enhance clarity and help users navigate the preserve's trail system.
- **Regulatory Signs:** Installation of updated signs indicating trail rules, permitted uses, and environmental protection guidelines.
- **Informational Signs:** Refreshed interpretive panels and educational displays about local flora, fauna, and the preserve's ecological importance.

Goals

- Improve user experience and accessibility for hikers, bikers, and equestrians.
- Enhance safety and regulatory compliance.
- Promote environmental education and stewardship.
- Ensure consistency and clarity across all trail signage.

- Staff working on-site during daylight hours, Monday through Friday.
- Signage installation will be completed in phases to minimize disruption.
